APAPA-SOC Summer Internship Program

Application Deadline: February 22, 2019

APAPA Solano County Chapter Summer Internship Program is designed to prepare college students to become future leaders in the State of California. This program provides an excellent opportunity for students to develop leadership skills, gain vital public policy experience, and become civically engaged.

The internship program will develop:

- Political awareness and civic engagement
- Understanding of government and legislative processes
- Professional and leadership qualities
- Networking skills with other fellow interns

Eligibility

The program is open to all undergraduate and graduate college students and recent high school graduates with a minimum *weighted* GPA of 2.75.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be selected on the basis of:

Demonstrated leadership
Interpersonal skills
Written and verbal communication skills
Teamwork skills
Community service
Grade point average

Program length and scholarship

Mandatory orientation will be held on June 14, 2019 4 PM – 6 PM.

The program runs from June 14, 2019 through August 16, 2019.

Interns will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$1000 at the end of the program.

Students are responsible for their own housing, transportation and insurance.

Requirements

- Attend the mandatory orientation on June 14, 2019.
- Work 100 hours minimum in your assigned office. The hours are flexible depending on the placement office and must be distributed over the length of the internship program.
- Register ten (10) people to vote.



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Requirements (cont.)

- Attend workshops. Workshops include leadership training, public speaking, voter registration, personal finance, project assignments, and other workshops.
- Attend the annual weekend API Alumni Leadership Conference at UC Berkeley on August 2, 2019 through August 4, 2019.
- Attend the annual Sacramento API Legislative Caucus on June 2019.
- Participate in National Night Out on August 6, 2019.
- Participate in the APAPA SOC Intern Celebration in August 2019.
- Keep a journal for the duration of the internship program.
- Complete an evaluation form after finishing your requirements.
