APAPA National Internship Program

APAPA places over 200+ college students with US Congressmembers, state constitutional officers and legislators, and mayors across the country. This program runs four sessions each year, and includes professional workshops, capstone projects, and chapter and community partnerships.



Educational & Cultural Initiative

APAPA has mobilized nationwide to support Asian American history and culture. We recognize the positive contributions of the AAPI community to this great country built by immigrants and their families. We believe this is vital to eradicating Asian Hate at its roots to empower our community.



Youth Leadership Academy

APAPA organizes events and programs aimed at empowering AAPI high school students. Our Youth Ambassadors work hand-in-hand with our Board Members to lead our chapters. We organize youth focused leadership workshops and events to provide opportunities to serve our greater community.



Unity Against Hate Movement

Leadership Development & Government Appts

APAPA provides programs to shatter the glass ceiling that exist for AAPIs in various industries. Our AAPI Women series is part of this program. We also have an APAPA Government Appointments Committee to increase AAPI representation on government boards.



Legislative Advocacy
